CARBON FREE

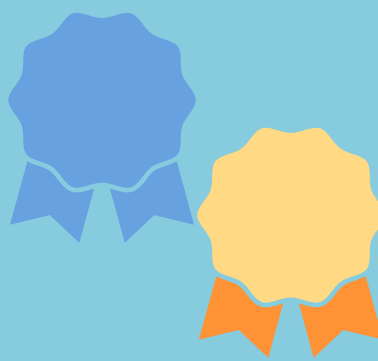

City facilities currently participate in multiple renewable energy programs. Today approximately 50% of the electricity that runs City buildings is carbon-free.

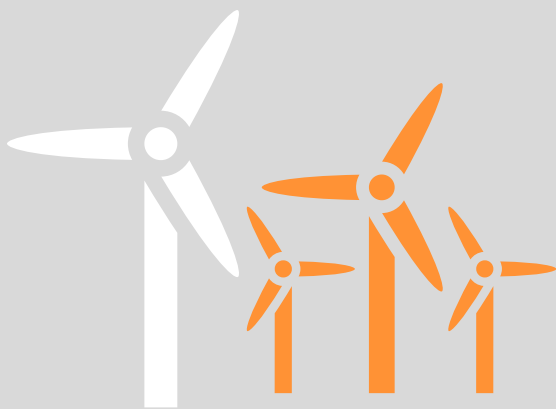
1ST GRADUATE
