I am writing to support granting landmark designation to 908 Rex Street. I have lived in Louisville for 35 years and have always enjoyed walking through the Frenchtown neighborhood and the history it recalls. 908 is a well-preserved and important example of the early 1920s style, and the proposed addition will respect the original feel of the house.

We sold our house at 609 LaFarge 20 years ago, and I deeply regret not seeking historical designation for it at the time. The new owners kept the building as is until they resold it in 2019 to a family that scraped it and put up a modern angular house that is totally out of character for the neighborhood. I'd hate to see that happen on Rex Street.
