

COVID-19 Inspection Process

The Building Department is restricting on-site inspections during this time in an effort to protect public health and prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Exterior & Commercial Spaces

Exterior inspections will be conducted in person. Inspectors must be able to maintain a minimum distance of six feet (6') from all other persons during the duration of the inspection.

The building permit, inspection card, and plans must be outside in an area protected from the weather for the inspector to review. Hand sanitizer and sanitary wipes are encouraged to be on-site for the inspectors and contractors to use.

Interior - Residential

Video inspections will take place for residential interior spaces. We will use Zoom, Skype, or Face Time as the media for the inspections. The inspector will call you during your inspection and give you instructions on how he will be conducting the inspection.

For the electrical, plumbing and mechanical work that was inspected by video, we will need a signed [affidavit](#) from the contractor that they did the work to 2017 NEC and the 2018 I-Codes as adopted by Louisville with the state license number for electrical and plumbing.
