

Summary of Local and State Orders for Businesses and Entities in Boulder County (November 13, 2020)

	Level Orange +BoCo Local Order	Stay at Home (Level Red)
Gatherings generally	10 people, two households max	none
Business Sectors Requirements:		
Office-based business	25% of employees may be in-person	Closed for in-person work; may carry out minimum basic operations
Retail	25% posted occupancy	Closed for in-person work or services but may operate to provide curbside, pickup, or delivery and to carry out minimum basic operations
Manufacturing	25% posted occupancy not to exceed 50 people per room	Closed for in-person work but may carry out minimum basic operations
Field Services	May operate; real estate must follow indoor events requirements	Closed for in-person work (including open houses for real estate)
Personal Services	25% of posted occupancy not to exceed 25 people per room	Closed for in-person work but may continue to carry out minimum basic operations
Limited Healthcare Settings	25% posted occupancy, not to exceed 25 people per room	Allowed to provide services ordered by medical, dental, or veterinary practitioners in accordance with Order 20-29 may operate at 25% of posted occupancy
Restaurants - Indoors	One household per table up to 50 people (excluding staff)	No indoor dining; may offer curbsides, takeout, and delivery
Restaurants – Outdoors	Two households per table up to 10 spaced 6 feet apart	Outdoor dining permitted two households per table up to 10 spaced 6 feet apart. Guidance for temporary structures.

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All Critical Businesses	Must follow sector guidance above for capacity and other requirements based on county level “unless doing so would make it impossible to carry out critical functions”	
Fitness/Recreation Industries:		
Gyms – Indoors (including pools)	25 people indoors (25% posted capacity) per room with social distancing	Closed Indoors
Gyms – Outdoors (including pools)	25 people per area with social distancing	10 people per class/outdoor area with social distancing
Ski Resorts	Permitted with BCPH approval	Permitted with BCPH approval (no indoor areas open; restaurants at ski resorts must follow restaurant requirements for curbside/takeout).
Outdoor Recreation Businesses/ “Outdoor Guided Activities” (e.g. horse back riding, guided tours, etc.)	25% capacity not to exceed 10 people with social distancing	10 people with social distancing
Other:		
Events – Indoors (indoor markets, theaters, trade shows, etc.)	25% not to exceed 25 people using social distancing calculator	Closed
Events – Outdoors (outdoor markets, outdoor concerts, etc.)	25% up to 75 people	Closed
P-12 schools – In person learning	Permitted with BCPH approval	Permitted with BCPH approval
Houses of Worship and Life Rites – Indoor	25% posted occupancy indoors not to exceed 50 people excluding staff per room	10 people or fewer with social distancing between non-households
Houses of Worship and Life Rites – Outdoor	Permitted with social distancing	Permitted with social distancing

Minimum Basic Operations. The minimum necessary activities to (1) maintain the value of the business’s inventory, ensure security, process payroll and employee benefits, or for related functions; or (2) facilitate employees of the business being able to continue to work remotely from their residences are allowable pursuant to this Order; continue filling online product orders and to process customer orders remotely. Any business supporting Minimum Basic Operations must comply at all times with Distancing Requirements.
