The City of Louisville is seeking highly qualified contractors for coating services at the Howard Berry Water Treatment Plant (HBWTP) for coating of the exterior roof deck of the existing uncoated 3.5 million gallon (180ft diameter) concrete water storage tank. Coating work includes the coating of the exterior roof deck along with the edge and underside of the roof that overhangs the tank walls. Tank is 180 ft. in diameter with a total coating area of approximately 27,000 sq. ft.
