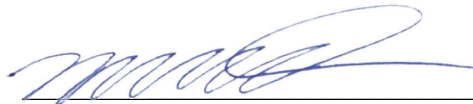
FINAL STATEMENT OF PETITION SUFFICIENCY

1. On October 25, 2021, a petition protesting against the effect of Ordinance No. 1811, Series 2021 was filed with the City Clerk pursuant to Title 31, Article 11 of the Colorado Revised Statutes and Article 7 of the Home Rule Charter for the City of Louisville.
2. On October 27, 2021, the City Clerk determined that the petition contained a sufficient number of valid signatures and issued an Initial Statement of Petition Sufficiency.
3. No protests were filed during the period provided in C.R.S. § 31-11-110.
4. Therefore, I hereby issue this final determination of petition sufficiency and shall refer Ordinance No. 1811, Series 2021 to the City Council for the City of Louisville for its reconsideration.
