In Re: Referendum Petition filed October 25, 2021 Concerning Ordinance No. 1811, Series 2021, An Ordinance Approving the First Amendment to ConocoPhillips Campus General Development Plan (Redtail Ridge Master Plan)

ORDER FIXING BALLOT TITLE

The undersigned City Clerk of the City of Louisville, Colorado, hereby finds and states as follows:

1. On October 25, 2021, a petition protesting against the effect of Ordinance No. 1811, Series 2021 was filed with the City Clerk pursuant to Title 31, Article 11 of the Colorado Revised Statutes and Article 7 of the Home Rule Charter for the City of Louisville.

2. On December 7, 2021 the City Clerk issued a Final Statement of Petition Sufficiency regarding the petition.

3. Pursuant to Louisville Home Rule Charter §7-4(c) and C.R.S. §31-11-111, the City Clerk on January 11, 2022, at 1:00 o'clock p.m. convened a public hearing in an electronic meeting concerning setting of the ballot title for the referendum.

4. Notice of said public hearing was provided to the proponents of the referendum petition and to the applicant/property owner of the subject property, Brue Baukol Capital Partners. Notice was also posted on the City's website and posted at the City's designated locations for posting of public notices.

5. The undersigned City Clerk, having reviewed the referendum petition, the relevant criteria for the settling of ballot titles, the comments provided at the public hearing, the various ballot titles suggested for the measure, and such other information as is relevant to this matter, hereby concludes that the ballot title for the above-referenced initiative shall be and is hereby fixed as follows:

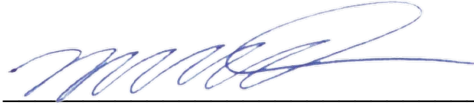

6. Any person presenting the referendum petition or any registered elector of the City who is not satisfied with the ballot title as herein fixed by the City Clerk and who claims that the ballot title does not conform to the criteria of state law may file with the

City Clerk within forty-eight hours after the title is set a motion for a rehearing on the ballot title. The rehearing shall be set, noticed and conducted in accordance with Louisville Municipal Code §1.16.045.
