Sec. 17.20.170 Electric vehicle charging infrastructure.

C. Number of required electric vehicle charging stations. The following table sets forth the number of required charging stations for all new development or redevelopments as required in for which a building permit is issued pursuant to the International Energy Conservation Code ("IECC") set

forth in Chapter 15.18 of the Louisville Municipal Code, except that **charging stations shall not only one electric vehicle capable charging station shall** be required for building permits issued pursuant to the 2018 Edition of the IECC. This list is not intended to be exhaustive of each use category, however is intended to establish general categories of use tiers. The Director of Planning and Building Safety shall determine the appropriate tier if the use is not identified in the table below.
