STATEMENT AND CERTIFICATE OF DETERMINATION
OF A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN LOUISVILLE, COLORADO
ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 9TH, 1986**

QUESTION I

SHALL THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE ADOPT AN ORDINANCE, WHICH WILL REQUIRE POLICIES THAT RELATE TO SCHOOL CLASS SIZE AND WATER SUPPLY, TO ISSUING RESIDENTIAL BUILDING PERMITS, SETTING A RESIDENTIAL GROWTH RATE, LIMITING RESIDENTIAL ANNEXATIONS, MAINTAINING A BUFFER ALONG U.S. 36, LIMITING ANNEXATION SOUTH OF U.S. 36, ENCOURAGING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A SUPERMARKET AND REQUIRING AN ELECTION TO CHANGE AGRICULTURAL ZONING?
