BALLOT ISSUE 2A

WITHOUT INCREASING ANY EXISTING TAX RATES AND WITHOUT IMPOSING ANY NEW TAX SHALL THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE, COLORADO ("CITY") BE AUTHORIZED TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, COLORADO ("TOWN"), WHICH AGREEMENT INCLUDES A MULTIPLE FISCAL YEAR OBLIGATION OF THE CITY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SHARING BY THE CITY AND TOWN OF SALES TAX REVENUES GENERATED FROM PARCELS OF LAND LOCATED ADJACENT TO OR NEAR U.S. HIGHWAY 36 AND DESCRIBED IN THE AGREEMENT, AND FOR THE PROPOSE OF ADDRESSING DISCONNECTION, ANNEXATION, AND OTHER ISSUES CONCERNING THE PARCELS OF LAND, THE LOUISVILLE/SUPERIOR INTERCHANGE AT MCCASLIN BOULEVARD AND U.S. HIGHWAY 36, AND OTHER MATTERS CONTAINED IN SUCH AGREEMENT, AND SHALL THE CITY BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT, RETAIN, AND EXPEND THE FULL AMOUNT OF SALES TAX REVENUE RECEIVED FROM THE TOWN PURSUANT TO SUCH AGREEMENT DURING THE YEAR 1997 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT YEAR, NOT WITHSTANDING ANY STATE LIMITATIONS ON FISCAL YEAR REVENUE AND SPENDING, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION THE RESTRICTIONS OF ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION?
