



Zoonotic Disease Report September 11 – September 17, 2022 (Week 37)

Executive Summary

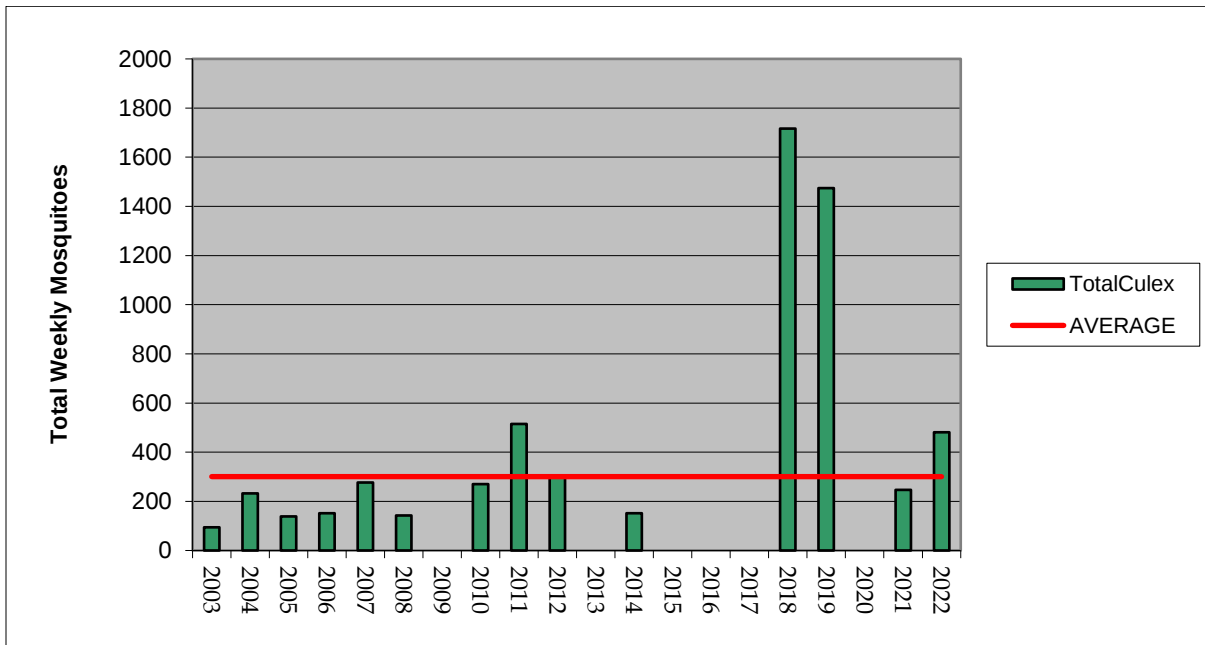
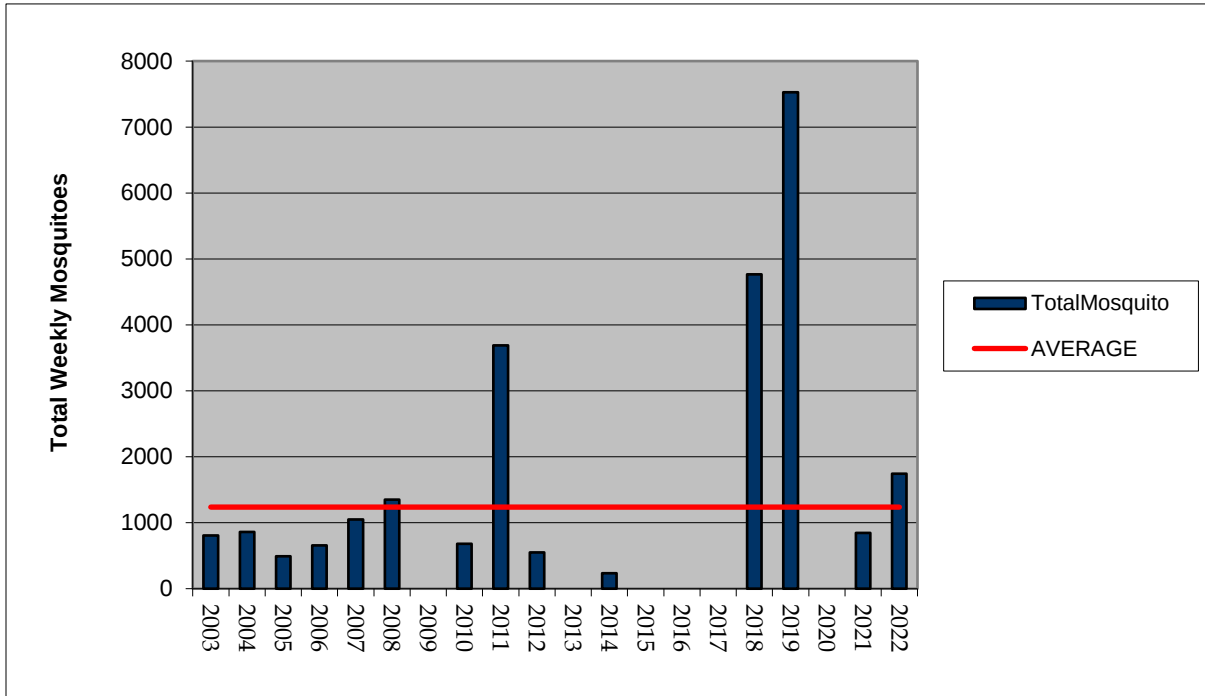
- Two bats and one raccoon were submitted for rabies testing. One bat and the raccoon were deemed untestable with the remaining bat testing positive.
- No specimens were submitted for plague, tularemia or hantavirus.
- Nuisance and *Culex* (WNV vectors) mosquito species are slightly above historic average for this week, however, overall numbers are down as we begin to exit the mosquito season.
- Two of seven mosquito pools tested positive from Zone 1 and Zone 3 in Week 36. Results are pending for four pools submitted for Week 37. Surveillance has concluded in Zone 2.
- CDPHE reports 249 WNV positive mosquito pools: Adams (7), Boulder (54), Denver (8), Larimer (116), Mesa (11), Weld (53). Actual Boulder County count is 59 underreported due to data lag.
- CDPHE reports 108 human WNV cases: Adams (13), Arapahoe (1), Boulder (21), Broomfield (5), Delta (10), Denver (4), Eagle (1), Elbert (1), Freemont (1), Jefferson (2), Larimer (10), Montrose (25), Weld (12).

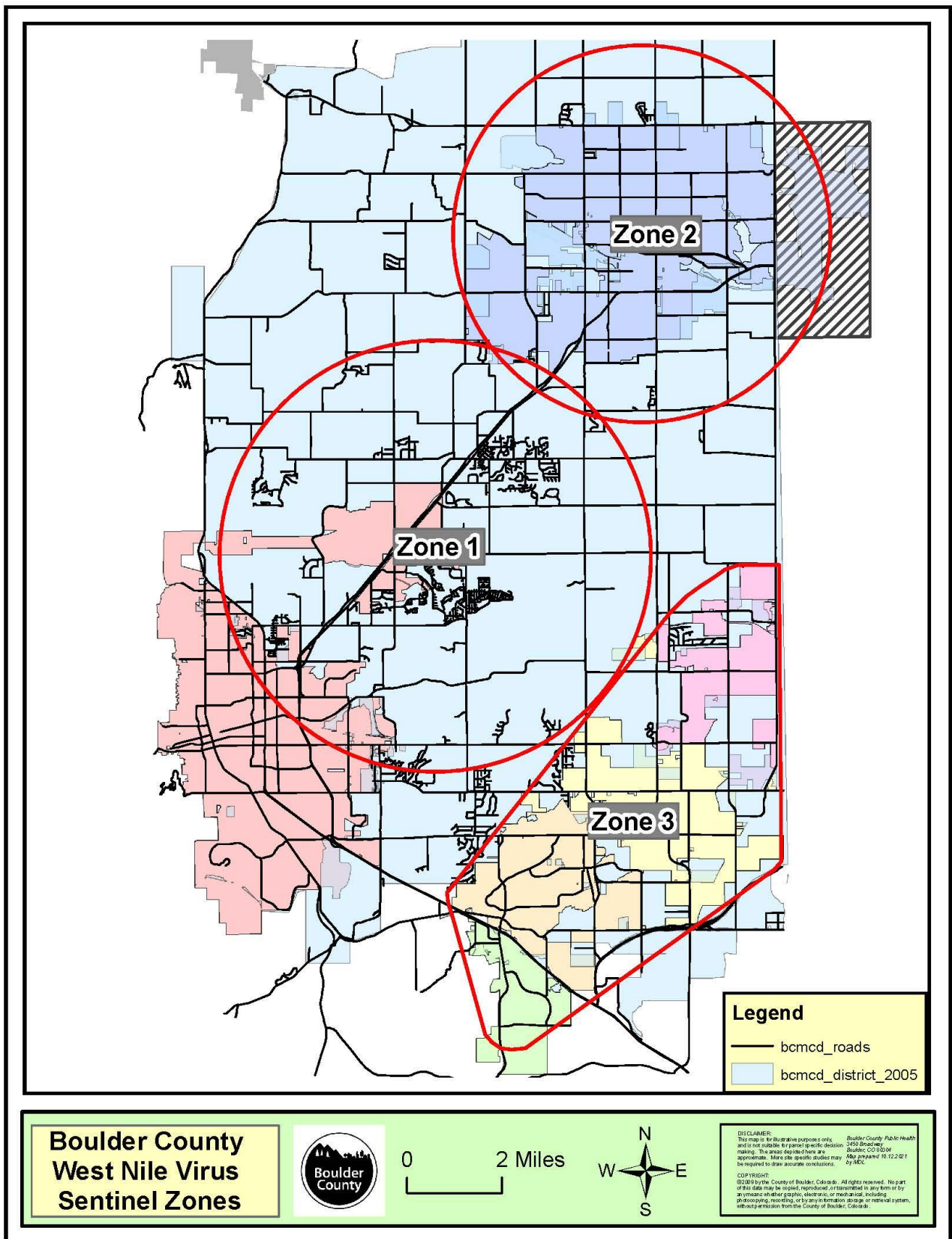

Animal Disease Activity

Each week, Boulder County and municipal Animal Control Units responds to animal complaints throughout the county. When deemed necessary, these specimens are sent to state laboratories for zoonotic disease testing.

Caveats

- Data are provided from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) Zoonotic database and may not include samples submitted for testing prior to publishing of this report.
- Data reflect all samples submitted by Boulder County Public Health, by other agencies or private veterinary practices.
- 'Positive Vectors' include only samples that have tested positive. Some samples submitted may be deemed untestable.
- 'Submitted Vectors' denoted with (*) indicate that at least one sample was untestable. Untestable samples may be treated as positive for follow-up protocol.

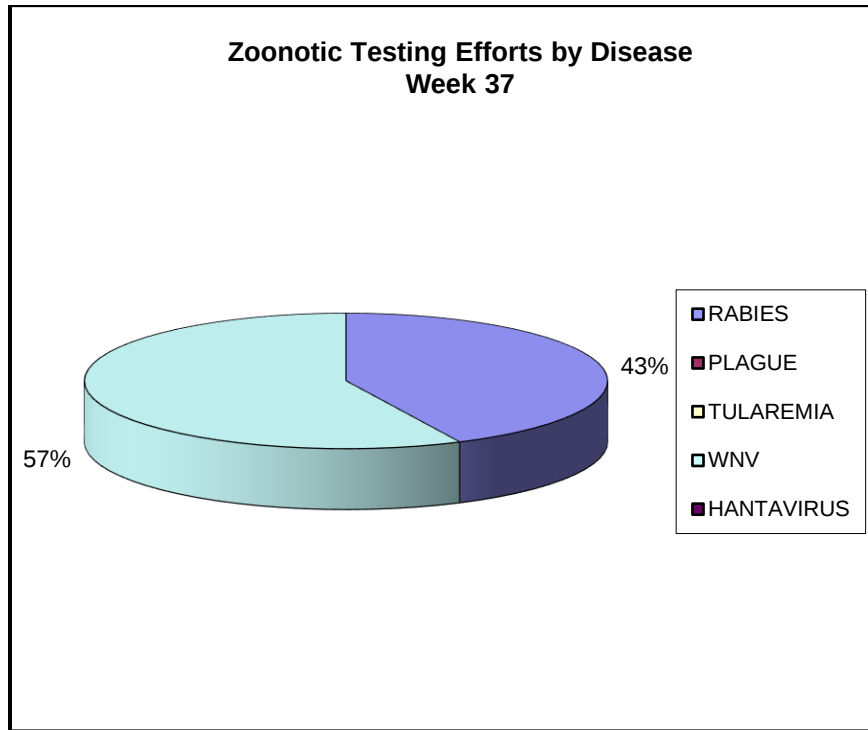
