

UPK Universal Preschool



The Family Application Opens January 17th!

How do I know if my child is eligible for UPK hours?

- 10 Hours** If your child turns *three-years-old* on or before October 1st, 2023 and has a *qualifying factor they will be eligible for part-time UPK.
- 15 Hours** If your child turns *four-years-old* on or before October 1st, 2023 they will be eligible for half-day UPK (15 hrs) or part-time UPK (10 hrs) depending on the program you choose.
- 30 Hours** If your child turns four-years-old on or before October 1st, 2023 and has a *qualifying factor they will be eligible for full-time UPK.

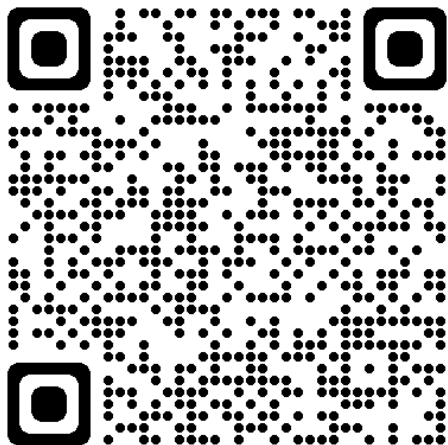
Who can be a UPK provider?

Any licensed provider in good standing with licensing can apply to be a Universal Preschool Provider. You can access this service with your current child care provider if they are participating.

How do I apply for UPK?

FAQs and Registration:

- ◆ Does this mean preschool is now free? No, you will be responsible for all additional hours.
- ◆ Does this guarantee my child a UPK spot in preschool? No, spots are limited, ask your provider if they are participating, this increases your chance of getting a slot.
