

Certification of Inactive Irrigation System

City of Louisville Water Customers who choose not to irrigate for the season may choose to complete and submit this certification of inactive irrigation system form to the Backflow Prevention & Cross-Connection Control (BPCCC) Program for consideration of waiving the backflow prevention assembly testing requirement for the irrigation system for ONE (1) year ONLY. A new form must be submitted for each year an irrigation system is inactive.

NOTE: Submission of this form does not guarantee the testing requirement waiver will be granted. The BPCCC Program will notify the customer by email if the request is granted or rejected, or if the request needs further documentation to grant.

B. CERTIFICATIONS

I, the customer, understand my responsibility to protect the potable water supply by:

- Preventing pollutants and contaminants from entering the potable water supply; and
- At my expense, annually testing the backflow prevention assembly on the irrigation system when the system is active and operational.

I, the customer, hereby understand and agree that to be considered for an inactive irrigation system waiver, I must comply with the following:

- If, at any point, I decide to make my system active I will first notify the City of Louisville BPCCC Program and arrange to have my irrigation system assembly tested before use of the system is permitted; and
- The City of Louisville BPCCC Program will routinely monitor irrigation use to determine compliance with this certification of inactive irrigation system form. Noncompliance with this certification will result in enforcement actions, including penalties and fines, and the irrigation system assembly will be subject to annual testing requirements.
