NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LOUISVILLE ON THE PROPOSED ADOPTION BY REFERENCE OF THE 2018
INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE AS AN ALTERNATIVE FOR THE
REPAIR AND REBUILDING OF HOMES THAT SUSTAINED SMOKE, HEAT, WATER,
ASH OR OTHER DAMAGE AS A RESULT OF THE MARSHALL FIRE

NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Louisville will hold a Public Hearing commencing at 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, December 19, 2023, at the Louisville City Hall, 749 Main Street, Louisville, Colorado, 80027.

The purpose of the hearing will be to consider adoption of an ordinance to adopt by reference the International Energy Conservation Code, 2018 Edition ("2018 IECC"), published by the International Code Council, 4051 West Flossmoor Road, Country Club Hills, Illinois, 60478-5795. The purpose of the 2018 IECC is to regulate and govern energy efficient building envelopes and the installation of energy efficient mechanical, lighting and power systems, and to provide for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor. If adopted, 2018 IECC requirements will have limited applicability to, and serve as an alternative for, the repair and rebuilding of homes that sustained smoke, heat, water, ash, or other damages a result of the Marshall Fire.

Copies of the code proposed to be adopted by reference are available for public inspection at the office of the Building Safety Division from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday.
