**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 13.12.105 TO ELIMINATE A WATER USE
REBATE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No 1515, Series 2007, the City Council recodified a "water rebate program" in Chapter 13.12 of the Louisville Municipal Code, known as the Annual Senior Water Rebate Program, and which Program has seen dwindling use over the years; and

WHEREAS, the City's Finance Committee has recommended that such Program be eliminated as a City rebate, to be replaced with donations from the City to a local non-profit that will administer assistance to those in need on a broader scale; and

WHEREAS, by this ordinance, the City Council desires to repeal Section 13.12.105 of the Louisville Municipal Code, making such funds available for such purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 13.12.105 of the Louisville Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

Section 2. If any portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each part hereof irrespective of the fact that any one part be declared invalid.

Section 3. The repeal or modification of any provision of the Municipal Code of the City of Louisville by this ordinance shall not release, extinguish, alter, modify, or change in whole or in part any penalty, forfeiture, or liability, either civil or criminal, which shall have

been incurred under such provision, and each provision shall be treated and held as still remaining in force for the purpose of sustaining any and all proper actions, suits, proceedings, and prosecutions for the enforcement of the penalty, forfeiture, or liability, as well as for the purpose of sustaining any judgment, decree, or order which can or may be rendered, entered, or made in such actions, suits, proceedings, or prosecutions.

Section 4. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.
