Second Reading Amendments

Ordinance No. 1887, Series 2024 is revised to read as follows (amendments are show in **bold underline** and **~~bold-strikeout~~**):

Sec. 17.16.340 – Natural medicine businesses

- A. *Distance from schools.* No natural medicine **healing center business** may be located within one thousand (1,000) feet of a child care center; preschool, elementary, middle, junior, or high school; or a residential child care facility. The distance shall be determined by a direct measurement from the nearest property line of the land used for a school or for child care to the nearest property line of the site containing the natural medicine business.
- B. *Hours of operation.* The provision of natural medicine services at a natural medicine healing center shall only occur between the hours of **6:00am** ~~8:00am~~ and **12:00am** ~~10:00pm~~.
