

**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF DESIGNATION OF PLACES FOR POSTING
NOTICES FOR PUBLIC MEETINGS**

SUMMARY:

Section 24-6-402(2)(c) of the Colorado Open Meetings Law requires all public bodies of the City designate the public place or places for posting of notices of public meetings. The designation must be made at the local body's first regular meeting of each calendar year.

Staff requests City Council approve the following locations for the posting of meeting notices for 2024:

- City Hall, 749 Main Street
- Police Department/Municipal Court, 992 West Via Appia
- Recreation/Senior Center, 900 West Via Appia
- Library, 951 Spruce Street
