- **Size:** 9"x9" to 14"x18"
- **One entry per student**

Submit Artwork by Wednesday, May 13

Each piece must include a **completed entry form** (provided separately). Be sure to write the student's name, age, phone number and email on the back.

- **Drop off** at the Youth Services Desk at the Louisville Public Library or at participating schools



Judging & Recognition

- Entries are evaluated by the Bee City Committee.
- Age groups: **K–2, 3–5, 6–8**
- Winners receive **Sweet Cow certificates**.
- Winning artwork is featured in a **City Council slideshow**.
- All artwork is displayed at the Louisville Public Library through summer.

Key Dates

- **Wednesday, May 13** – Artwork due
 - Drop off at Louisville Public Library **or** Bee City will pick up from participating schools
- **Monday, May 18** – Winners announced and Sweet Cow certificates awarded
- **Summer 2026**
 - Winning artwork recognized at a City Council meeting (slideshow and student recognition)
 - Artwork displayed at the Louisville Public Library
- **August 2026** – Artwork can be picked up from the Louisville Public Library when school resumes
